Ana Pogacnik is an international Geomancy instructor, accomplished musician and composer, founder of Schule "Wieder Sehen" (School "To See Again"), and co-author of the book How Wide the Heart: The Roots of Peace in Palestine and Israel. She was born 1973 in Slovenia but has lived in Munich since 2005.

Ana first studied piano at the Conservatory in Ljubljana and then later archeology at Ljubljana University specializing in prehistory. In 2002 she started developing her own educational program through Schule "Wieder Sehen" called "A Deeper Cognition of Landscape." Ana works with several groups of students in Europe and around the world, including most recently North America.

**Friday Evening October 9-Sunday Afternoon October 11
Alcatraz/Angel Islands, San Francisco, CA**

Alcatraz and Angel islands are infamous, both in their significance for local Native Americans and as places where prisoners and immigrants were interned by the U.S. government in the last two centuries.

In this weekend seminar, we will visit places on these islands, and other locations in the San Francisco bay area, that are important for the surrounding landscape, and be led to truly 'see' these places in a new way. Through individual and group exercises and practices, movement, singing, toning, art and guided meditation, we will work together to reveal, transform and heal long forgotten qualities of these landscapes. In the process, we will uncover deeply imprinted memories and solve many riddles that the landscape is carrying and is offering to us as the mirror through which we can recognise, understand and heal many unsolved questions about ourselves and our lives.

Cost for the seminar will be \$225. Ferry and park admission fees, and accommodations, are not included.
